- The way we learn and work is innovative and future-focused. Work experience placements play a prominent role in this.


Albeda's vision for good education:

4. Future-focused: we offer innovative and future-focused courses. We respond to relevant trends and teach our students the skills of the future.
5. Practice-oriented: we choose powerful, practise-oriented learning environments. Inside and outside the school: in the form of work experience placements, a digital learning environment, and internships.
6. Pedagogic-didactic professionalism: the guarantee for the quality and innovation of our education.
7. Career-focused: every form of education and guidance is aimed at the student's career development.
8. Alliances: to make sure our education stays relevant, we form lasting collaborations and alliances with companies and organisations, locally, regionally, nationally, and internationally.

This also includes gaining international experience, achieved through internal and external mobility, but certainly also through blended projects. Albeda works closely and happily with Erasmus+.

In 2016, Albeda received the quality label from Erasmus+ for the first time, and Albeda was accredited for internationalization activities in February 2021. The accreditation is awarded for the period up to 2027, with the maximum points available achieved for *relevance, objectives, activities, and management*.
